Victory in Jesus!

Everyone that is born again is no longer a victim, but they are a victor. Now I'm not saying that your problems will magically disappear when you receive Jesus as your Savior, but I am saying that you will no longer have to face them alone or fix them alone. Jesus didn't come to this earth for Himself; He came to bring the help we need from Heaven.

There are a lot of bad things happening right now to people on planet earth; some worse than others. But Jesus connects Heaven's power to those who believe in Him to bring His salvation. It's kind of like if you want electrical power in your house, you have to contact the power company. They will then connect you to their power source so that you can enjoy different electrical devices in your home. Jesus connects us to all that God has, and all things are possible to people that believe this.

After a person receives Jesus, they must start thinking like a victor; not a victim. They must start declaring that they are a victor in Jesus, and stop talking 'poor me'. If you're hooked up to the power company, don't act like you have no power. Turn that TV on; turn your washer on; turn the lights on. You might ask, "How do I turn God's power on in my life?" I'm glad you asked that question. Let's look at the Bible to find the answer.

Luke 10:17-20 KJV [17] And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Thy Name. [18] And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from Heaven. [19] Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. [20] Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in Heaven.

Notice that these disciples of Jesus were excited, because they had power to cast out devils in Jesus' Name. This is the key; we must have faith in the Name of Jesus. Let's look at more Scriptures that talk about this.

John 14:13-14; 16:23-24 KJV [13] And whatsoever ye shall ask in My Name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. [14] If ye shall ask any thing in My Name, I will do it.

16:23-24 [23] And in that day ye shall ask Me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you. [24] Hitherto have ye asked nothing in My Name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

Acts 4:7-10 KJV [7] And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this? [8] Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, [9] If we this day be

examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; [10] Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Whom ye crucified, Whom God raised from the dead, even by Him doth this man stand here before you whole.

1 John 3:22-23 KJV [22] And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. [23] And this is His commandment, That we should believe on the Name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as He gave us commandment.

In these Scriptures we see that we are now in a position, as believers, to receive Heaven's power in our lives. We should no longer act as victims. With God on our side, who can be against us?

Romans 8:31-32 KJV [31] What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

I hope you will remove any kind of victim mentality from your mind; because if you don't, you will not be able to tap into Heaven's power to bring victory in your life. You are more than a conqueror through Jesus!
