Sin Has Been Conquered!

Christians today that are trying to defeat sin have never really received a full understanding that sin has already been defeated by Jesus. As Christians, we have an advantage that the Old Testament saints could never live in. When Jesus came to this earth, He came to take our sins upon Himself; and when Jesus was on the cross, He was paying the price for our sins. Jesus became sin, even though He had never sinned, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV For He hath made Him to be sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

On that cross, Jesus was defeating our adversary the devil. Because of our sins, the devil had power over us; and because he is the lord of sin, he could rule us. No longer can he do that now, because our sins are gone when we accept Jesus.

Hebrews 10:16-19 KJV This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; [17] And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. [18] Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. [19] Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,

In the mind of our Father God, He doesn't hold our sins against us; because He allowed our sins to be put on Jesus, then the punishment for our sins was administered to Jesus instead of to us. So we are not only not going to be punished for our sins, but we now also have the power to rule sin; because sin lost its power over us when we receive Jesus Who defeated sin on the cross. We must believe this to go free.

Romans 5:6-10 KJV For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. [7] For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. [8] But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. [10] For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Galatians 2:16-21 KJV Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. [17] But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid. [18] For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor. [19] For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God. [20] I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, Who loved me, and gave Himself for me. [21] I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.
