Jesus: The True Know It All

Jesus knows it all, and freedom comes when He reveals His knowledge to us. He came to this earth not to just die on the cross for our sins; He also came to teach the world everything that He received from His Father. Mankind must understand what God understands, or they will walk in darkness and have no understanding. Let's look at some verses that bear this out.

John 8:12 KJV Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I Am the light of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

When Jesus says that He is the light of life, He is saying that He is the Person that understands God-Life; the way God lives, the way God thinks; and He came to teach you all about His Father's way of doing and living.

Now, later on in this chapter Jesus says these things...

John 8:26-27, 31-32 KJV I have many things to say and to judge of you: but He that sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him. [27] They understood not that He spake to them of the Father...[31]Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on

Him, If ye continue in My Word, then are ye My disciples indeed; [32] And ye shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free.

Jesus was the only Man on the earth that completely understood God the Father, so He could teach about Him completely correctly. The reason this was true is because Jesus was the Father God's only Begotten. Now we became sons of God after His death and resurrection.

Many people do not know Who God is, because they have not received Jesus, His Son, to teach them. This Newsletter is to teach us to focus on Jesus the Teacher; not just on Him as the sacrifice for mankind's sins.

Now let's look at some more of Jesus showing His Father's heart.

John 8:3-11 KJV And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto Him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst, [4] They say unto Him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. [5] Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest Thou? [6] This they said, tempting Him, that they might have to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down, and with His finger wrote on the ground, as though He heard them not. [7] So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. [8] And again He stooped down, and

wrote on the ground. [9] And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst. [10] When Jesus had lifted up Himself, and saw none but the woman, He said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? Hath no man condemned thee? [11] She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

Jesus knew His Father God didn't want this woman condemned to death, but the Jews didn't know God's will. They said Moses says the law says. Jesus knew that the law was only valid till the seed came and Jesus was the Seed!

Galatians 3:18-19 KJV For if the inheritance be of the law, it is no more of promise: but God gave it to Abraham by promise. [19] Wherefore then serveth the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the Seed should come to Whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

Jesus came to become the final sacrifice. Before Jesus came, mankind could only pay for their sins through the sacrificing of animals; but when Jesus showed up, God sacrificed His Son for their sins. People having to pay for their sins was over.

Hebrews 9:26-28 KJV For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. [27] And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: [28] So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation.
