The Bible: The Christian's Final Authority

Christians, I challenge you to make the Bible your final Authority in your life. If you don't do this, you might find yourself fighting against God. I've been a born again Christian over 40 years now, and I've seen so many people that serve the Lord only half way. They have received Jesus as their personal Savior, and I believe they are going to Heaven when they die; but their belief system doesn't agree with the Bible; sadly, it matches the world. The traditions of men have made the Word of God of no effect in their lives. Let's study some Scriptures today that deal with this.

Jesus said this in Mark 7:13 KJV Making the Word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

What does tradition mean? It is the handing down of information, beliefs, and customs by word of mouth or by example from one generation to another without written instruction.

We can see in the dictionary definition that men pass down a way of living and thinking without really sitting down and writing a book on it. Mankind teaches people by just living a certain way. To break these generational traditions, man must allow God's Word to be final Authority. The way we have lived must change to line up with the way God wants us to live.

When we start changing our lives by living God's Words, we will not fit in with this ungodly world's traditions. Jesus told us in His Word that this would happen. Let's look at what He said.

Matthew 10:34-40 KJV Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. [35] For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. [36] And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. [37] He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. [38] And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after Me, is not worthy of Me. [39] He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for My sake shall find it. [40] He that receiveth you receiveth Me, and he that receiveth Me receiveth Him that sent Me.

In the world we live in today, we see a very clear distinction between people that love the Lord and follow His Word those that reject Him and His Word. The reason this is happening is because Jesus said that these things would be happening in the last days. We are coming to the final days of this world. God has allowed man to mock Him with

their ungodly living for a long time; but just like before the flood, He is getting fed up with it, and He will put a stop to it!

2 Peter 3:3-13 KJV Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, [4] And saying, Where is the promise of His coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. [5] For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the Word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: [6] Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: [7] But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same Word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. [8] But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. [9] The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. [10] But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. [11] Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, [12] Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? [13] Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

I leave you with this: if you have been living the traditions of this world and rejecting God, remember He loves you and He has already died for your sin. Repent and start living for Him. Even if you get rejected by men, you will be pleasing to your Heavenly Father.
