Pastor Paul's Newsletter 6-8-25
Signs of the Time!**

Jesus told us when He was coming back by telling us what would be happening right before His return. In this Newsletter, we will be showing Scripture verses that point these times out. I'm a person that believes that the Church in our generation will be the Church that reveals His return and then takes actions that will result in His return. Let us look at some of these Scriptures.

2 Peter 3:9 KJV The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Mark 16:15-17 KJV And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

In these verses we see God's heart in that He doesn't want any person to perish. He wants everyone to be saved. Now you might ask, "How can He get them saved?" Well, He chose a very unique way. He just has to have people that will preach His message and pray with them to receive the Lord Jesus as their

very own Lord and Savior. Let's look at Scriptures that bear this out.

Romans 10:8-17 KJV But what saith it? The Word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the Word of faith, which we preach; [9] That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. [11] For the Scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on Him shall not be ashamed. [12] For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon Him. [13] For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved. [14] How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? [15] And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! [16] But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? [17] So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

These Scriptures show that the preacher is very important for people to get saved; because we are saved by faith, and the preacher is called by God to preach to people the message that will produce faith to be saved.

I believe that the generation we are living in will see Jesus come back. The reason I say that is because we have more God-called preaching going on now than any other time in history. Let's look at what Jesus said about His return.

Matthew 24:14 KJV And this gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Think about this: when one person preaches the gospel and it is recorded, it's possible that a thousand people could hear that message and be born again and saved. That one message that saved a thousand could be used by the 1000 to help tens of thousands to be saved. Now we could put that message on the radio and on the internet, and now millions could be saved. Now think about this: if you have millions of people preaching the message of Jesus' love and salvation, and they record it and others listen to it, we are in for the most powerful time of modern day history. The technology we have right now can really get the salvation message out to all nations of the earth so that Jesus can come back! We are living in that day right now!! I'm so excited that Jesus could come back before this Newsletter ever gets into your hands! You will have a glorified body, if you're a born-again Christian when Jesus returns; and we will live forever in a body that is just like Jesus' body...and it will never die!

1 Corinthians 1:17-18 KJV For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the

cross of Christ should be made of none effect. [18] For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

So let us go and preach this gospel, and watch Jesus come back.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 KJV But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. [14] For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with Him. [15] For this we say unto you by the Word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. [16] For the Lord Himself shall descend from Heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: [17] Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. [18] Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
