**How to Understand the Bible**

When a person becomes a born-again Christian, they basically are starting at the beginning of God's understanding. The way that we come to understand what God understands is by the methods that He has chosen to educate us spiritually. Christians that are young in the Lord cannot just read the Bible and understand it without the help of those that are older in the Lord and that have studied the Scriptures for a long time. The Bible teaches us that the elder shall teach the younger. Also there are offices that God has ordained and put in the church to educate and develop His children. So let's go to some Scripture verses today that give us this understanding.

Ephesians 4:11-13 KJV And He gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; [12] For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:[13] Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

Ephesians 4:11-13 NLT Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the

evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. [12] Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do His work and build up the church, the body of Christ. [13] This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

Ephesians 4:11-13 AMPC And His gifts were [varied; He Himself appointed and gave men to us] some to be apostles (special messengers), some prophets (inspired preachers and expounders), some evangelists (preachers of the Gospel, traveling missionaries), some pastors (shepherds of His flock) and teachers. [12] His intention was the perfecting and the full equipping of the saints (His consecrated people), [that they should do] the work of ministering toward building up Christ's body (the church), [13] [That it might develop] until we all attain oneness in the faith and in the comprehension of the [full and accurate] knowledge of the Son of God, that [we might arrive] at really mature manhood (the completeness of personality which is nothing less than the standard height of Christ's own perfection), the measure of the stature of the fullness of the Christ and the completeness found in Him.

The devil looks at Christians that are young in the Lord, and he wants to stop their spiritual development. He knows that they have the potential to grow up and be like Jesus, because they were born from the Seed of Jesus spiritually. Satan's main job is to keep all of the young Christians away from spiritually-mature Christians; especially those that teach the Bible and really have a revelation. Because you're reading this newsletter, I know that you are striving to grow up spiritually and to live out a life from Heaven while you're still on the Earth. Hallelujah!

The Apostle Paul is the man in the Bible that gives us more revelation knowledge about who we, the church, are. Before the church started, there was a lot of the Bible written to people that were not born-again Christians; so they didn't have the ability to live out God's desire on the earth. The Apostle Paul is basically the major apostle of the Bible that God chose to educate His church. So we must spend a lot of our study time in his writings to grow up spiritually. When we mature in Christ, we will be able to do the works of our Father God on the earth.
