Spiritual Death = Separation From God

We as Christians are no longer separated from God. However, when we were born as babies, we were born with a sin nature and, therefore, started living a life of sin.

Romans 6:23 KJV For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Remember that spiritual death is separation from God. When Jesus came to the earth, His mission was to blot out our sins so that we could be brought back to God. A born-again Christian is not separated from God anymore. The sins that they have committed have been blotted out by the blood of Jesus.

Acts 3:19 KJV Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

Now that my sins are blotted out, I'm no longer separated from God. Now let me give you some examples of separation.

If someone put a plastic bag over my head, I could die physically, because I would be separated from oxygen. If I was in the desert and ran out of water, I could die physically; because I would be separated from water. We could go on and on with illustrations of being separated from natural things that can cause physical death. Now, just think about being separated from God Who created and sustains all of the things in this natural world. When we are brought back to Him and we are not separated anymore, our lives will be supplied with His personhood. Everything we could ever need is in Him, and we are now connected to Him.

I remember when I worked for Public Service Company. Anytime there was a storm and the power went off, I had to work overtime to help the company restore power to their customers. Jesus worked overtime to get our sins remitted so that our Father God could turn the power back on in our lives. We must believe it to receive it. God's power is restored to us, so take it by faith and be free!

Isaiah 43:25-26 KJV I, even I, am He that blotteth out thy transgressions for Mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins. [26] Put Me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

We have been brought back to our God, and He will help us.

Hebrews 13:5-6 KJV Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

[6] So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

I'm not separated from my Father God anymore, because my sins have been removed by the blood of Jesus!

Hebrews 9:22 KJV And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.
