I'm Bold and Not Afraid!!!

God is calling Christians to step up in these last days and to not be afraid to speak what you have learned from your Heavenly Father. When Jesus was on the earth, He learned what His father taught Him then He spoke it to the world He lived in. He was not afraid or ashamed! The people that believed His words and embraced Him as their Lord and Savior were saved, and the ones that didn't went to a devil's hell.

The devil doesn't want us to speak God's words, because he knows that anyone who hears and believes what we say and confesses Jesus as their Lord will be saved. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Romans 10:13-15 KJV For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved. [14] How then shall they call on Him in Whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? [15] And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

Notice that people can't be saved without a preacher. Now many Christians have said, "I'm not a preacher, I can't preach like a pastor would". The devil has used this against Christians in order to keep their mouths shut. The word 'preacher' is the same as a proclaimer. We proclaim to people the truth about Jesus and what He has done for us. As we do this, God uses our words to produce faith; so the person can believe in Jesus and receive Him as their Savior.

Romans 10:17 KJV So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.

The fear of rejection in our modern day is great. There are millions of Christians on planet earth, and if they all started talking to people about Jesus next week, there would be so much faith come to people that thousands and probably millions would be saved.

Let's look at more Scriptures to show us.

Romans 1:16-17 KJV For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. [17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

We see in these verses that because Paul is not ashamed to speak the truth about Jesus, many are saved; he wasn't afraid! At this time people were being killed if anyone preached in the Name of Jesus. Eventually Paul was killed, because he kept on telling

people about Jesus being the Messiah.

I want to encourage you to pray about being a voice for Jesus in these last days. If you're afraid to tell people that are not Christians how they can become one, you can break that power of fear through the Holy Ghost.

2 Timothy 1:6-9 KJV Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. [7] For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. [8] Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; [9] Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

The world is waiting on a bold Church that's not ashamed of Jesus Christ!
