Jesus Finished Our Sins on the Cross; We Must Enter In

Romans 5:8-10 KJV But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. [10] For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

In today's Newsletter I'm going to share a revelation with you that will set you free, if you receive it by faith. We are going to be talking about entering into the finished work of Jesus. Each one of us that have received Jesus as our personal Savior has entered into His finished work. There is nothing we can do that Jesus hasn't already done to loose us from the punishment for our sins, Period!!!! The devil wants you to think that what Jesus did wasn't enough for us to be in right standing with our Father God. When we receive Jesus, we are receiving what He did on the cross so that we can go free.

Romans 8:29-33 KJV For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the Firstborn among many brethren. [30] Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified. [31] What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? [33] Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.

In verse 32 It reads, "He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" I believe that if we, by faith, receive what Jesus worked for us on the cross, we can forever break the devil's power over our lives. Because Verse 33 says 'who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect?' We are God's elect! He chose us and removed our sins through His Son's blood. Trying to

do our own works to be right with God will always lead us into the devil's condemnation.

In the Old Testament, the Israelites were put under the law of Moses. If they didn't do what was required of them, based on what the law said, they could receive great punishment, and even sometimes the punishment of physical death. When Jesus came, He took the sins of the people and was punished on the cross for them. What killed Jesus on the cross was not just the nails in his hands and feet and the spear in his side, but our sins and the sins of the whole world were being punished as Jesus was crucified. So many people I know that have been born again do not understand that Jesus was punished with our punishment. God doesn't punish born-again Christians for their sins, because He has already done it on Jesus' cross. Many Christians think that they can pay for their sins through their good works. We do good works because we love God; not because we are afraid of being punished. The devil can impersonate God. He tells Christians that they are not good enough, he tells them that God doesn't love them because of their sins of the flesh. He must be stopped! The only way to stop him is to reveal his lies. Look at these verses as I close this Newsletter.

Hebrews 10:16-19 KJV This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; [17] And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. [18] Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. [19] Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,

John 3:16-18 KJV For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. [17] For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. [18] He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned

already, because he hath not believed in the Name of the only begotten Son of God.
