What Causes a Christian To Be Stable?

I'm convinced that a Christian cannot be stable in the storms of this life without being a student of God's Word and making it final authority in their life. When Jesus was being hit by the devil in Matthew 4, we see Jesus over powered the devil with the Word of God! Jesus did not win against the devil with His feelings. He did not win with His opinions. He won by speaking out His Father's words from the Old Testament. In fact the New Testament hadn't been written yet. The Church hadn't started, because Jesus hadn't yet died for mankind's sins.

The devil wants the Church to be be spiritually ignorant. If God's children do not study the Bible, they will not know God. God and His Word are synonymous. When you read the Bible, you are actually reading God!

Matthew 4:1-11 KJV Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. [2] And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He was afterward an hungred. [3] And when the tempter came to Him, he said, If Thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. [4] But He answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. [5] Then the devil taketh Him up into the Holy City, and setteth Him on a pinnacle of the temple, [6] And saith unto Him, If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down: for it is written, He shall give His angels charge concerning Thee: and in their hands they shall bear Thee up, lest at any time Thou dash Thy foot against a stone. [7] Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. [8] Again, the devil taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; [9] And saith unto Him, All these things will I give Thee, if Thou wilt fall down and worship me. [10] Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and Him only shalt thou serve. [11] Then the devil leaveth Him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto Him.

John 1:1,14 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

[14] And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the Only Begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

1 Peter 1:23 KJV Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

1 John 3:8-9 KJV He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the

works of the devil. [9] Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for His seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Mark 4:14-20 KJV The sower soweth the Word. [15] And these are they by the way side, where the Word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the Word that was sown in their hearts. [16] And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the Word, immediately receive it with gladness; [17] And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the Word's sake, immediately they are offended. [18] And these are they which are sown among thorns; such as hear the Word, [19] And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the Word, and it becometh unfruitful. [20] And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the Word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.

In all of these Scriptures, we see God doing what He does through His Word. We are born again through His Word, and we do what He wants us to do by His Word.

Hebrews 10:7 KJV Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the Book it is written of Me,) to do Thy will, O God.

Jesus became man by the Word of God. God's Word to Mary was a Seed that was planted in her womb. She had never been with a man; it was a miracle that came from the Word of God that was spoken by the prophets of the Old Testament.

The Bible is called the Holy Bible, because God is the One that inspired men to write it. No one should ever speak against it, because it is God speaking to His people.
