READ Revelation 11**OBSERVE**

1. Read 1 Peter 2:5, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 2 Corinthians 6:16 and Ephesians 2:19-22. What is the purpose of the Church? How do we see that purpose reflected in Revelation 11? (1-13)
2. What happens when the seventh trumpet is blown? (14-19) Why is this significant for us today?

INTERPRET

1. Where in our world does it seem like Satan and sin are winning?
2. How should we, the people of God, respond when it seems like Satan and sin are winning in the world?

ASSESS

1. How closely are your life and relationship to community aligned with God's purpose for the church?
2. In our last meeting we talked about being a witness for God. How have you been a witness for God over the past 2 weeks?
3. How can you grow as a confident witness?
4. How do the witnesses in Revelation 11 respond to suffering? In what ways are your responses to suffering like or unlike the witnesses' responses?
5. What does the rule and reign of Jesus look like? How does your life reflect his rule and reign? How does it fail to reflect his rule and reign?
