1. _____ of Corruption

This is not merely a limitation but an absolute prohibition of all corrupt talk. From foul language to coarse joking, all manner of speech that is filthy must depart the vocabulary of every Christian.

"The good person out of the good treasure of his heart produces good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure produces evil, for out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks." ~ Luke 6:45

2. _____ through Words

You have, through your words, the opportunity to lift others up and encourage them to greater faith. Each occasion you experience has its own peculiar need for edifying words.

And Judas and Silas, who were themselves prophets, encouraged and strengthened the brothers with many words. ~ Acts 15:32

3. _____ of Grace

Do you consider your life to be the means by which other can come in contact with the grace of Christ? Christians are to use their words to bring a sense of God's grace to those who listen.
