1. The Vacancy of _____

It is empty to think that the mere constraint of worldly regulations will provide the motivation to hold you off from yielding to temptation. The fear of earthly judgment might keep you from committing a crime, but it will not cleanse you from sin.

"Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first." ~ Matthew 12:45

It is vanity to believe that we can invent a religious condition that will satisfy God Almighty, let alone remove from us our inner wickedness. In the end, it is only an outward show that does nothing to purify the heart.

With true salvation comes a new life. If you are dead to this world and alive in Christ, you have a new nature that is more akin to God than to the old self. Therefore, set your attentions on those things that will build your life anew.

We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. ~ Romans 6:4

So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions.
