Luke 2:28-35

HE IS...

1. The _____ from God

Jesus is salvation. There is no other. Those who look to themselves in the hopes of being saved are looking upon futility. We must come to Christ and hold fast to Him, for the Almighty God has sent His Son—and will send no other.

Acts 4:12 ~ "And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

2. The _____ of Revelation

Jesus is the revelation to the world. We must bring people to look upon Him who is the Light of the World that they should see and believe. He is also glory to Israel for it is through the nation that Jesus has come.

Acts 26:23 ~ "...that the Christ must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, he would proclaim light both to our people and to the Gentiles."

Luke 12:51 ~ "Do you think that I have come to give peace on earth? No, I tell you, but rather division."

2 Timothy 3:8 ~ Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith.

Hebrews 2:9

But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.
