



IceBreaker: Reference a season where you experienced a pretty bad leader or a season where you experienced an amazing leader.

Introduction *(Read aloud before discussion.)*

We are finishing our series in Psalm 23 as we talk about how we can experience unimaginable peace as we allow the Lord, our Shepherd, to actually lead our lives.

Sermon Discussion *(Use as a guide for dialogue; let God lead, and read the verses aloud.)*

1. **Psalm 23.** Read through the entire psalm and comment on moments that connect peace (or the idea of peace) with allowing the Lord to lead us through life.
2. Why is peace the result of good leadership, and anxiety or stress the result of experiencing bad leadership?
3. What often keeps us from completely giving our good Shepherd the reins in our lives as we trust him to lead us?
4. What could you do practically and intentionally that would allow you to become the kind of person who would really lean into being led by the good Shepherd?
5. **John 10:11-15.** Talk about following the kind of leader that would actually lay down his / her life for those they are leading.
6. How does our actual view of God, what we actually think about him, contribute to whether we actually submit to his leadership in every area of our lives?
