# PRE-SERVICE Activity & Coloring Pages

What you need:

- K-2 “The Book of Mark Cross” coloring page, “Jairus’s Daughter” coloring page,
- Memory Verse I Love You” Activity Page, “Find Jesus” Activity Page
- 3-5 ”Verse Word Search” Activity Page, “Word Search Key” Activity Page, “Love Game” Activity Page, “Love Game” Instructions
- Coloring supplies
- 3-5 Scissors

Welcome kids by name as they arrive with a high five, fist bump, or a wave!

Put out the coloring supplies and coloring and activity pages so they are waiting for the kids as they come in. Explain that they can choose to work on whatever they want and can move between the activities if they wish.

## **K-2 Coloring Pages**

“The Book of Mark Cross” coloring page, “Jairus’s Daughter” coloring page

### **Memory Verse I Love You” Activity Page**

- Say, “Every time you see the word I, draw a cross by the word.”
- “Every time they see the word LOVE, draw a heart around it.”
- “Every time you see the word YOU, draw a smiley face around it.”
- Decorate around the verse.

### **“Find Jesus” Activity Page**

- Give kids a “Find Jesus” Activity Page
- Tell them that Jesus is hidden somewhere in the big crowd of people.
- Challenge them to look circle Him and color the rest of the page.

## **3-5 Coloring Pages**

“Mark Graffiti” coloring Page

### **“Verse Word Search”**

- Point to the Memory Verse at the bottom of the page - “I give you a new command. Love one another. You must love one another, just as I have loved you” John 13:34.
- Explain that all the words from the verse are hidden in the puzzle.
- Challenge them to find and circle as many words from the verse as they can.

### **“Love Game” Activity Page**

- Guide kids through the process of coloring and folding using the “Love Game Folding Instructions” Activity Page.
- Once it’s folded, encourage the kids to look at the different sections.
- Let them play with a partner. One person spells out Love while opening and closing it, picks a number, counts it out, and then reads the message of love inside.

**Transition** - In our Bible Story today, we’re going to see Jesus show His amazing love to some people who really, really needed it. Let’s go!”

What You Need

**HOST:** *“Hey, everyone! Welcome back to another awesome week here at Fusion Kids!”*

*“It’s the final week of our series ‘Like and Subscribe: Share the Love of Jesus!’*

*“This series is called ‘Like and Subscribe,’ because when you see something awesome online, you like it and subscribe to it because you don’t want to miss a minute of awesomeness. And you want to share that awesomeness with your friends and family too!”*

*“This month, we’re talking about the love of God! That’s definitely not something you want to miss a second of! And you so want to share it! This week, we’re going to take a deeper dive into a situation that happened with Jesus.”*

*“We’re going to talk about what it means to share the love of Jesus, to notice people, to help people, and to stay connected to God and each other. In today’s story, there was a huge crowd around Jesus! So today’s game will give you a taste of what it was like to be part of a huge crowd around Jesus.”*

*“Turn to the person next to you and say, ‘It’s about to get crowded!’ (Pause as the kids respond.)*

*“This game is called ‘It’s Crowded!’ and trust me ... it’s going to get tight in here.”*

**SLIDE:** It’s Crowded! Title

*“Here’s how it works: We’ve got two teams of four that will start behind this starting line here. Each team has a Hula Hoop®, that’s your =crowd zone.’ When I say GO, the first kid on each team will run to the Hula Hoop, hold up this sign that says, =It’s Crowded!’, and that’s the signal for the next teammate to run.*

*“Each runner has to get inside the Hula Hoop, take the sign, lift it high, and shout, ‘It’s crowded!’ before the next teammate runs and gets inside the Hula Hoop. The goal is for your whole team to fit inside your Hula Hoop first—no toes, elbows, or knees outside the circle!*

*“Once everyone’s in and you’re holding up your sign, yell ‘It’s crowded!’ as loud as you can. The first team to do it wins!*

## OPENER GAME (CONT.)

*"I need eight kids who want to play. If you want to play the game, raise your hand!"*

**Choose eight kids from the kids who have their hands raised. Direct both teams to stand behind the start line.**

*"Team One, are you ready and have your first kid picked? Team Two, are you ready and have your first kid ready to go? Great! 3 ... 2 ... 1 ... GO!"*

**AUDIO:** Upbeat music

*"Team One's off to a quick start! Team Two's squeezing in, look at that teamwork! Ooh, careful, don't crush any toes! Can they fit everyone?"*

*"We've got a winner!"*

*"Nice work, everyone! That got crowded fast! You had to make space, stay balanced, and work together to fit everyone in."*

**SLIDE:** Bottom Line

*"That's kind of what it was like in our story today. Jesus was surrounded by a huge crowd—everyone wanted to see Him. But even in that crowd, Jesus still noticed people who needed His help. He didn't push anyone away. He made room."*

*"Even when it seems like there's so much going on and there are so many other people trying to get attention, even when everyone's busy, Jesus still sees you. And He can help us see and love others too."*

## SMALL GROUP

### Activity 1 “Boom, Clap, Snatch”

What You Need:

- Soft heart for every two kids

### What You Do

- Encourage two kids to sit facing each other, about an arm’s length apart.
- Place heart on the floor between them.
- Explain you are going to play “Boom, Clap, Snatch.”
- Explain that when you say “Boom” everyone should slap the floor/ table.
- Explain that when you say “Clap” everyone should clap once.
- Explain that when you say “Snatch” everyone should try to grab the heart.
- The kid who grabs the heart first, wins!
- Begin the game by calling out a command (Boom, Clap, or Snatch)
- The kids must do the action you call out.
- If a kid snatches the heart when you didn’t say, “Snatch,” the other kid wins.
- Let the winners compete with one another.

### What You Say

“That game takes some serious focus and quick reflexes! You have to be ready to act when the moment is right.”

## SMALL GROUP

### Activity 2

#### “Story Card Race”

What You Need

- “Story Events” Activity Page

#### What You Do

- Divide the group into two teams.
- Give each team a set of the story cards, all mixed up and placed face down in a pile.
- On “Go,” teams race to flip over their cards and put them in the correct order to retell the story.
- The first team to get the story in the right order wins.
- Once both teams are finished, use the cards to retell the story together:
  1. A man named Jairus asked Jesus for help because his daughter was very sick.
  2. On the way to Jairus’s house, a big crowd was all around Jesus.
  3. A woman who had been sick for a very long time reached out and touched Jesus’ cloak.
  4. Jesus felt power go out from Him and asked, “Who touched me?”
  5. The woman was scared, but she told Jesus what she had done. Jesus was kind and told her she was healed!
  6. Jesus got to Jairus’s house and took the little girl by the hand and healed her too!

#### What You Say

*“Great job putting that story in order! Jesus was on His way to do something very important, but He still stopped to help the woman who was in need. When the people told Jairus that his daughter was dead, Jesus told him, ‘Don’t be afraid. Just believe’ (Mark 5:36 NIV). Jesus completely healed the woman in an instant and raised the girl back to life! He showed love to both people! We can be like Jesus and [Bottom Line] show the love of Jesus to people in need.”*

## SMALL GROUP

### PRAY AND DISMISS

#### “Prayer Hearts”

##### What You Need

- Jar
- Hearts

#### What You Do

- Invite the kids to form a circle with you.
- Show the group the prayer jar with hearts in it.
- Give each kid a heart.
- Ask your group to think of one person they know who might need Jesus’ love this week. (Maybe it’s someone who is sick, like the people in our story, or maybe someone who is feeling sad.)
- Explain that God knows what’s in our hearts, and so if we want to pray silently for that person, we can. God hears the words in our hearts!
- Go around the circle, and if a kid wants to share, let them say the person’s name and pray for them. But if they don’t feel comfortable sharing a name, encourage them to pray silently for that person. (Share with them that they can pray in their heart, “Jesus, [this person] needs Your help. Please help [this person].”)
- Encourage the kid to put their heart in the prayer jar to represent that person.
- Continue until everyone has had a turn to say a name and gets to pray if they want.
- Say, “Praying for people is a way to share the love of Jesus. We have prayed for so many people this month and asked for God’s help! Great job, you guys!”
- Close the group in prayer

#### What You Say


“The best part of prayer is that we can pray and talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything! It’s so good to pray for people. It’s one of the best ways we can [Bottom Line] show the love of Jesus to people in need. Let’s pray together now.

#### Prayer

“Dear God, thank You for being so loving and kind. Thank You for healing the people in our story and for always being ready to help us when we are in need. Please be with the people we prayed for today. Show them Your love. Help us to be like Jesus and show Your love to everyone we meet. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus’ name. Amen.”
