PRE-SERVICE GAME

What You Need

- Colored construction paper (one color per child)
- Colored wooden craft sticks (multiple colors)
- Timer (30 seconds)

What You Do

Color Grab Game Instructions

1. Give each child a piece of colored construction paper.
2. Place a pile of colored wooden craft sticks in the center of the table.
3. When the leader says “GO!”, kids have 30 seconds to grab sticks that match the color of their paper.
4. Kids must place the matching sticks on top of their construction paper.
5. When time is up, count the sticks.
6. The child with the most sticks that match their paper color wins!

What You Do

Say this:

“Hi friends! I am SO happy to see you today!
Can everyone wave at me? (pause)
Great waving!

Today we are going to talk about something really special.

We are going to talk about **WORSHIP**.

Can you say that with me?
WOR-SHIP! (pause)

Worship is when we tell God we love Him.
We can worship God with our **words**, our **songs**,
and our **bodies**.”

“Let’s think about how we can worship God.

- Can we worship God with our hands?
Let me see you clap your hands! (pause)
- Can we worship God with our voices?
Let me hear you say, ‘Thank You, God!’ (pause)
- Can we worship God with our bodies?
Let me see you jump for joy! (pause)

Wow! You are GREAT worshippers!”

Say together:

“I can worship God!”

(Have kids repeat 2 times)

Have kids sit down. Hold up the Bible.

Say this:

“This is the Bible.

The Bible is God’s Word.

The Bible tells us about God.

Today the Bible tells us something very special.

The Bible says:

‘Worship the Lord with gladness.’

That means we worship God with **happy hearts**.

God loves us!

God made us!

God takes care of us!

That is why we worship God!”

Let’s watch a story about someone who loved God and worshipped Him.

He wasn’t shy—he worshipped God with all his heart!

SMALL GROUP

APPLICATION 1

What You Need

- Paper plates
- Rice
- Ribbons
- Crayons & markers
- Stapler (teacher use)
- Scissors

What You Do

Leader says:

“Let’s make an instrument to worship God!

Leader says:

Fold your paper plate in half.

Write the Bible verse on both sides of the plate:

“Worship the Lord with gladness” - Psalm 100:2

Open the plate and add a small amount of rice to the middle.

Staple the paper plate shut all the way around (adult help recommended).

Use a hole punch to make holes along the edge of the plate.

Cut ribbons into short strips.

Thread the ribbons through the holes and tie knots to secure them.

Decorate your shaker with extra ribbon if you’d like.

Shake your paper plate and worship the Lord with gladness!
