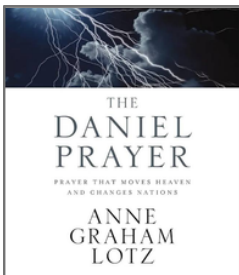


### Day Time WOM Bible Study Group

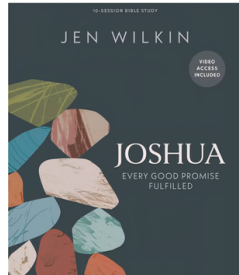
