1. **Conduct** -The following expectations are designed to help make camp a safe and positive experience for everyone. Those who **CHOOSE** to violate them will automatically terminate their stay at Purity Retreat 2020.

- a. **Guys and Girls may not enter each other's living areas for any reason at any time.**
- b. No use of tobacco, alcohol or narcotics will be allowed at any time.
- c. No fireworks or firearms are allowed.
- d. Those who are currently in a dating relationship will be allowed to hold hands and nothing else.
- e. Practical Jokes will not be tolerated in any form.
- f. Sneaking out of rooms after curfew or failure to be on time for a planned event will not be tolerated.
- g. Tampering with someone's belongings in any way will not be tolerated.
- h. Fighting and Bullying will not be tolerated.
- i. Respect for ALL ADULTS is mandatory. Disrespect will be immediately confronted.
- j. Cooperation is mandatory! If one of our sponsors asks you to do something, you are fully expected to cooperate.

2. Dress Code

4. Medical/Health Issues :

Prescription Medications - If your student is taking medications you will need to turn these in at the Registration table on Feb 21. Please turn in the exact amount that your student will need for the time that we will be gone. These medications need to be in their prescription bottles showing the Dr.'s name, the student's name and the correct dosage. We will have large zip-loc bags available to you to place these in when you come to load. Medications will be administered daily by an Adult Counselor.

Other Medications - Please do not bring any other kinds of medications with you. No one will be allowed to have any medications in their possession at camp.

Also, everyone who goes to camp will be expected to eat at meal times.

If while we are at camp, some illness prevents a student from having a meaningful experience, we will make arrangements to transport that student home.
