### The Role of the Student Pastor

- This position is Lifehouse's Student Ministry representative to the community of South Central Nebraska. It is encouraged that this position partners with Schools Leaders, City leaders, and Para Church ministry leaders to influence as many students as possible to have faith in Jesus Christ.
