



Romans 2:25-29

Trusting in Religious Practices

- I. **Introduction:** Paul told the Roman believers that Jewish people should not rely on their circumcision to get them into heaven, but upon conversion of the heart.

- II. Trusting in Religious Practices (**Rom 2:25-29**).
 - A. The Value of Circumcision (**v. 25**).
 1. Paul proclaimed that there was only value in circumcision if one obeyed the law perfectly, but that circumcision does not guarantee salvation.

 - B. The Reality of Uncircumcision (**vv. 26-27**).
 1. Paul's point is that a Gentile belongs to God's covenant family through faith in Christ, whose obedience satisfies the law where circumcision never could.

 - C. The Nature of Circumcision (**vv. 28-29**).
 1. Paul declared that true Jews were those who were not just circumcised in their physical bodies, but were circumcised in their hearts by the Holy Spirit.

- III. **Conclusion:** Paul says that not everyone who claims to be a Jew is a true Jew, but only those who have been justified by Christ and transformed by His spirit.



Questions About: Trusting in Religious Practices

1. How did Paul address the Jews in Romans? (**Rom 2:17-29**) What did Jews believe would save them from God's wrath? (**vv. 25-29**) Why did they think circumcision would save them?
2. What did Paul say was the value of circumcision? (**Rom 2:25**) To whom did God give the sign of circumcision? (**Gen 17:9-14**) What was the significance of circumcision? (**Rom 4:11-13**)
3. How did Paul say God would regard their circumcision if they didn't obey the Law? (**Rom 2:25**) Why did Jews refer to Gentiles as uncircumcised? (**1 Sam 17:26**) How was it an insult?
4. How would God treat Gentiles who kept His Law? (**Rom 2:26-27**) How would Gentiles be treated like Jews by God if they obeyed? (**v. 26**) How could they keep the Law? (**Matt 5:17**)
5. Why did Paul say that Gentiles would judge Jews? (**Rom 2:26-27**) How would they become witnesses against them? (**Luke 11:29-32**) Who did Jesus say was their father? (**John 8:31-59**)
6. What did Paul say was the true nature of circumcision? (**Rom 2:28-29**) What does it mean that not every Jew was a true Jew? (**Rom 9:6**) Why was circumcision not an indicator of salvation?
7. What did Paul mean when he said they need to be circumcised in the heart? (**Rom 2:28-29**) What did this mean to the Jews? (**Deut 30:6; Jer 4:4**) Why did they need heart surgery?
8. How did the new covenant promise the Jews a new heart? (**Ezek 36:24-28**) How was Israel repeatedly hard-hearted? (**Acts 7:51**) What hope does God offer sinners? (**Psa 51:10**)

1. Pray that God would bring conviction of sin to religious people who need salvation.
2. Ask God to help you honor Him by helping you to repent of your sins.
