



Romans 3:9-14

The Whole World is Guilty (Part 1)

I. **Introduction:** Paul proclaimed that God rightfully condemns every person because they are dominated by sin and are helpless to free themselves from its power.

II. The Whole World is Guilty (**Rom 3:9-14**).

A. God's Condemnation Pronounced (**v. 9**).

1. Paul announces God's verdict that the whole human race is under His judgment because both Jews and Greeks are guilty sinners.

B. God's Charges Presented (**vv. 10-14**).

1. Paul lays out God's airtight case against humanity, demonstrating that everything about human beings condemns them before their eternal judge.

III. **Conclusion:** God has indicted the entire human race as guilty and deserving of judgment because both Jews and Greeks are unrighteous sinners.

4. What is the significance of righteousness in Romans? (**Rom 3:10**) How does God charge mankind with being spiritually ignorant? (**Rom 3:11**) Why is man unaware? (**1 Cor 2:14**)

5. Why does God say that man does not seek Him? (**Rom 3:11**) Who is the true Seeker? (**Gen 3:8-10; Luke 19:10**) How does God charge man with being naturally wayward? (**Rom 3:12**)

6. How has man turned aside from God? (**Isa 53:6**) Why does God charge humanity with being spiritually worthless? (**v. 12**) How does God indict man of being morally corrupt? (**Rom 3:12**)

7. What does God say about mankind's speech? (**Rom 3:13-14**) What does it mean that his throat is an open grave? (**v. 13**) How does God charge mankind with being deceptive? (**Rom 3:13**)

8. Why does God compare man's lips to those of an asp? (**Rom 3:13**) What does God say man's speech contains? (**Rom 3:13**) What is God's overall assessment of humanity? (**Rom 3:10**)

1. Pray that God would reveal to you how unrighteous we are as human beings.
2. Ask God to help you love people enough to tell them the good news.
