But he replied, "Why do you ask my name?" Then he blessed him there.

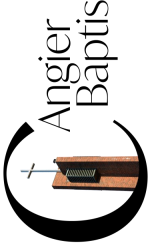
³⁰ So Jacob called the place Peniel, saying, "It is because I saw God face to face, and yet my life was spared."
