Justice: verdict (favorable or unfavorable), discretion, judgement, ordinance, right + wrong, worthy Psalm 9:7-8; Isaiah 9:7; Zechariah 7:9

Integrity: blameless, upright, innocently; quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness.

Distorts: perverse, crooked, perverted, twisted out of shape; giving a misleading or false account or impression.

- ✓ By d_____: humiliates his father; disobedience is proof of foolishness.
