The First Angel: Revelation 14:6-7

*Flying _____; **NKJV**: *midst of heaven* meaning mid-heaven (mid-sky) the point in the noonday sky where the sun reaches its zenith. This is the highest and brightest point where all can see and hear.

*With the eternal gospel; everlasting gospel to preach to the inhabitants of the earth; to every _____, _____, _____ and _____.

*He spoke with a loud voice.

Notice the details of the first angel’s message.

* _____ God; Greek word *phobeo*: fear, dread, terrified, afraid, reverential obedience.

*Give Him _____; Greek word *doxa*: praise, honor, especially divine quality, splendor.

*Worship the one who made _____ and _____ the sea and the springs of water.

Worship Greek *proskuneo*: pro (towards) kuneo (kiss) to do reverence, to kiss, a willingness to make all necessary physical gestures of obeisance

-Endurance Greek word hypomone; steadfastness, patient waiting, constancy holding on to God's commands and our faith in Jesus.

-Blessed Greek word Makario; happy, to be envied, supremely blessed, fortunate, well off.

-Rest Greek word anapaesontai; be exempt, to refresh

-Good reputation
