**9 Oil and incense bring joy to the heart, and the sweetness of a friend is better than self-counsel.**

**What is the main theme of this verse?**

➤ The value of a good f\_\_\_\_\_ advice.

**Notice the benefits of a friend’s advice:**

**Oil:** Frequently used in the Hebrew culture; set apart people, places, and objects for holy service. Used to refresh, sooth wounds, calming.

**Incense:** Perfume, smoke, fragrant; the ascending column of smoke symbolized accepted worship. Used in the temple, gladdening power, heartfelt supplication.

**What does King Solomon mean by the sweetness of a friend?**

\*Pleasantness

\*Discernment

➤ Sweetness is not just r\_\_\_\_\_ to taste, but this term also extends to relationships that draw the listener or friend toward wisdom and joy. King Solomon says this sweetness is better than self-counsel.

**How could you use this verse to help someone who is strong willed?**

➤ Proverbs 27:17; Ecclesiastes 4:9-10; Galatians 6:2

**10 Don't abandon your friend or your father's friend, and don't go to your brother's house in your time of calamity; better a neighbor nearby than a brother far away.**

**What is the main idea of this verse?**

➤ Sometimes f\_\_\_\_\_ are closer than f\_\_\_\_\_.

King Solomon is not saying we should ignore our family, but rather we should not depend on our family in times of crisis just because they're family.

**How do we balance this dynamic between friends and family?**

#1 Don't a\_\_\_\_\_ your friend (neighbor); leave, depart, be absent, let go; context includes: family life, covenant loyalty, warfare, worship and commitment to the Lord. In contrast to human frailties God never abandons His people.

#2 Don't a\_\_\_\_\_ at your brother's (relatives) house in your time of trouble. Suddenly showing up at a family member's house that you are not close with, in the midst of a difficulty may make things worse and cause unnecessary stress.

**What is the contrast of this verse?**

The sensible are the wise who have a proper understanding of God, His Word, and His will. One of the indicators of a wise person is their ability to notice risks and take appropriate steps.

The inexperienced are the unwise who reject God, His Word, and His will. Those who lack wisdom also lack the self-control to notice danger and therefore suffer the consequences of bad decisions.
