Fear: Reverence for the Lord and respect for government leaders; Notice the order, #1 the Lord, as well #2 the king. A proper relationship with God produces good citizenship, but an unruly citizen violates God's commandment to Love the Lord.

Here the writer emphasizes the importance of true justice.

It is not good to show partiality in judgment.

Partiality: unfair bias in favor of one thing or person compared with another; f _____, negative or positive; in this verse he is referring to an improper /negative judgement. Discretion, law ordinance, justice.

Notice the illustration and consequence:

From a negative perspective he says, **whoever says to the guilty, “You are innocent”—peoples will curse him, and nations will denounce him;**

Whether it is in the formal courtroom or in our daily task, we should be aware of what we say about the wicked and the innocent because they are attached to a burden or a blessing.
