

A Word for the Backslider

Jeremiah 3:6-17

Do you believe the Lord can redeem a person who has backslidden? Sadly, many who were once faithful have turned away and as a result, are discouraged in the possibility of being restored back to God. In light of this, how should we defend God's Word and encourage them to return? In a portion of this prophetic book, Jeremiah recalls a time when God told him to preach a message to Israel, inviting them to return to an everlasting fellowship with the Lord. Who can you share this message of hope with today?

Three Encouraging Attributes About the Lord for the Backslider

- **The Lord is Aware of the Backslider: (v. 6-10)**

- **The Lord is Merciful with the Backslider: (v. 11-13)**

- **The Lord is Good to the Backslider: (v. 14-17)**
