Luke 7:36-50

How do we encourage the churched among us who are unaware of their own sinful hearts? In a portion of Luke's Gospel, he recalls a time when Jesus met with a Pharisee who was more aware of a woman's sin of the flesh than of his own sin of pride. As we read this story of sin, forgiveness, and gratitude, why is it important to express your love and appreciation for what Jesus did for you? Who can you encourage with this message today?

Contrast Of Sin, Forgiveness, And Gratitude

● The Sinful Woman: (v.36-38; 48; 50)

● The Self Righteous Man: (v.39-47; 49)

Application:

- ✓ In your prayer time, ask God to convict your heart of any sin that is offensive to Him.
