Four Virtues of Eternal Peace

- **Peace Has A Unique Nature (v. 27a)**
- **Peace Has A Divine Origin (v. 27b)**
- **Peace Opposes Worldliness (v. 27c)**
- **Peace Demands Confidence & Courage (v. 27d)**
