With Spring hopefully not too far off, many people are looking forward to getting their yards and gardens ready. Stores are stocking up on potting mixes, mulches, new plants and all the tools that go with the season.

Jesus' parable in Mark 4:26-29 describes how our gardens grow. He also said, "This is what the Kingdom of God is like. A man scatters seed on the ground. Night and day, whether he sleeps or gets up, the seed sprouts and grows, though he does not know how. All by itself the soil produces grain—first the stalk, then the head, then the full kernel in the head. As soon as the grain is ripe, he puts the sickle to it, because the harvest has come."

Notice that Jesus identifies how the process works. "Night and day...the seed sprouts and grows...all by itself the soil produces grain." Gardening is an example of our partnership with God, but with God doing the miraculous! That is a wonderful metaphor of life. We each have our part to play but God does the heavy lifting – God does the miraculous. *What miraculous things is God waiting to do in your life? Dig in!*


We have entered into phase 2 of the youth room update! Take a look:
