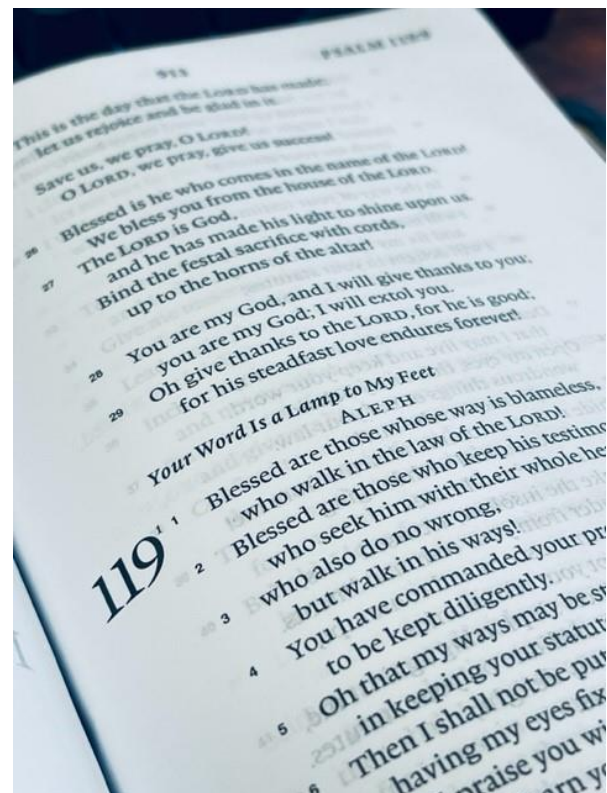

king david's psalm

The longest chapter in the Bible is Psalm 119, written by King David. It has 176 verses. In this Psalm, David writes an acrostic of the Hebrew alphabet. Most English Bibles will divide up the Psalm by showing you the Hebrew letter or spelling it out in English transliteration. For example, the first eight verses all start with an Aleph or א. As King David sings and prays to the Lord he identifies three things about a life lived under the Triune God. A Christian is one who prays (in Latin, Oremus) to his God. We pray because God has commanded us to pray, but he also promises to hear us when we pray. The Christian speaks to God as a child speaks to his father. A Christian meditates (Meditatio) on the Word of God. The world would have you meditate on phrases and things or lack of things to clear



your mind, but the Holy Spirit through David's pen bids you center your mind and heart on the Word of God. It is this Word of God that informs your prayer. You open your mouth in prayer because the Lord has opened your lips. A Christian suffers spiritual attack or affliction (Tentatio). This spiritual attack comes when one meditates on the Word of God. The enemies of God do not want you to meditate on the Word. They mount their attack against your God by sending affliction your way. Psalm 119:153: "Look on my affliction and deliver me, for I do not forget your law." This is the God who has saved you! He hears your cries and comes down to deliver you. The Cross of Jesus breaks and hinders the evil plans and purposes of the devil, the world, and your sinful nature. During this Advent season, meditate on Psalm 119. May it show you the good and gracious will of your Heavenly Father and fill your heart with his Word as you pray to him. God will strengthen you for the attack and he will guide you as his own. Nothing will separate you from his love. "Give me life according to your steadfast love. The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your just and righteous decrees endures forever," Psalm 119:159b-160.

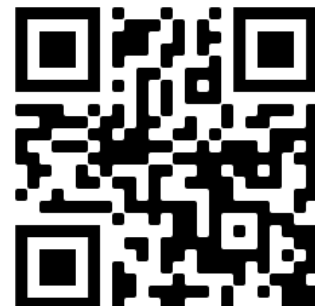

DEARLY BELOVED SPONSORS,

Blessed All Saints' Day, to you in the name of our Lord Jesus who shed His blood on the cross, hence endowing you with sainthood. Amen.

The month of October 2022 has been a remarkable month to be remembered. It was embedded with mixed emotions. Among others, the Independence Day celebration was not without its own ordeal: the so-called Muslim Jihadists/bandits terrorized and vandalized some villages and worship centers that day.

Later in the month, a devastating flood occurred. It is still ravaging lives and many properties, such as schools, churches, homes, farmlands, and businesses. This has also affected members of The LCN. A close friend lost his family home, business place, and even the three-story commercial building. All of these losses are without aid and/or without any effective insurance system in a Muslim-dominated federal government.

This flood was not without storm. A portion of our old residential security fence was totally damaged. Thanks be to God that the new sections of the security fence, constructed during Covid-lockdowns, survived the storm. My plantain garden was also affected.

Amidst these aforementioned calamities, JEM Lutheran Seminary observed the following:

- On October 18, we joined the Church Universal to celebrate the festival of St. Luke, the Evangelist. The Rev'd Professor Ibok Luke was the preacher and also the presiding minister.
- Orientation of this year's new students was on Thursday, October 20.
- Matriculation exercise to induct the new students was held on Saturday, October 22.
- The festival of St James, Brother of our Lord, was the occasion for the opening service of the 2022/23 academic year -- Sunday, October 23.
- On October 28, the school commemorated Saints Simon and Jude, Apostles.
- Reformation Day was celebrated on October 31.

During the matriculation, the chairperson of JEM Lutheran Seminary board of governors [comparable to a board of regents] thanked the new students for their willingness to study toward the Holy Ministry in these troubled times of the country, when Christians (and pastors in particular) are the major target of Islamic terrorist groups.

In the opening service, the first Vice President of the LCN, the Rt. Rev'd Raphael O. Aju who represented the Archbishop of the LCN, His Grace, the Most Rev'd Dr. Christian O. Ekong — preached on "Diligence and Faithfulness to the Confessions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church," based on Paul's letter to Timothy.

On Reformation Day, I preached and presided in the Divine Service at the Lutheran high school next door before returning afterwards for the Divine Service in the seminary, where I also preached and presided. I preached two different sermons, and we prayed using two different setting of the liturgy (LSB's Setting Three at the high school and Setting Five at the JEML Seminary).

Our traditional Reformation barbecue event was celebrated right after the Divine Service at the seminary. The Archbishop/President of the LCN added yet again another positive flavor by matching the two goats that I was able to squeeze out from my meagre income. This gave the seminary community a total of four he-goats. It was a very welcome relief as the total number of students this year increased, and I was unable to provide my usual four to five he-goats. The students are still jubilating with the leftovers. To God alone glory be! Amen.
