Trunk or Treat Guidelines

Participating vehicles will need to be parked in the lot by the Early Childhood Building, Gym and Playground no later than 11:45 am (or simply park there before church), Sunday, October 30, 2022.

Open up and decorate your trunk or the back of your vehicle. Please, *NOTHING* spooky, gory, or violent – please keep decorations and costumes "kid friendly." Possibilities could include a Reformation theme, sports, comic characters, Biblical, exotic locations, a particular decade – and can be as elaborate or simple as you wish. If lights are needed, please make sure they're battery powered, as electricity will not be available on site.

Please be health conscious for yourself and others. We are inviting all to take part and want all to feel safe. Consider laying out treats individually so the child can grab one and not dig through a bowl. A table could be used to separate you from the crowd so you can still stock the table with candy but remain socially distant. If you would like to dress up as well, consider a costume with gloves, and a mask as part of the ensemble. Remain at your vehicle for the duration of the event. Bring some lawn chairs to sit in and compliment the kids' costumes! Meet a family! Have fun!

For candy, please only bring store-bought individually wrapped treats. Or consider giving out a non-candy treat (bubbles, toys, other small prizes). We could have over 200 children at the event.

This year's event is 3 hours, ending at 3:00 pm. For safety reasons, please plan to stay parked and decorated until 3pm, breaking down your decorations and leaving after that. If you would like to donate leftover, individually wrapped candy after this event to go to active US troops, there will be a container at the event for your donations. Questions? dear brothers and sisters in christ:

God sends forth his holy Word into our hearts to plant faith (Romans 10:17). It has to come from outside of us. In Latin that's extra nos. The Holy Spirit has called us by the Gospel, enlightened us with his gifts, even as he sanctifies and keeps us in the true faith. Left on our own we could do nothing, even with the Holy Spirit calling and gifting, our sinful nature fights, kicking and screaming, to keep our old sinful ways and to rejoice in our own desires and pleasures.

God knows that our Old Adam keeps showing his head and tempting us to sin and great shame and vice. He is extremely generous with his Gospel (Psalm 23:5). He is extremely slow to anger and he is abounding in steadfast love (Exodus 34:6). He daily and richly forgives your sins. He calls you to where his Word is preached and his sacraments are given and where his people are gathered around those holy things.

Dear Christian, the attack, which we know so well, is heightened and intensified toward our children. The desire of the devil is to destroy the faith of our little ones and knock our children off the path that God's Word has set for them. Our enemies have rallied the world to an open and frontal attack. They use television, the internet, professional sports clubs, and all matter of common and daily aspects of our life. The Lord is not unaware of the cunning nature of the enemy. He provides, equips, guards, and protects. How does he do it? With his Word. It is the measuring stick for everything in this body and life. He encourages us to a life with the Word in our homes, in our daily routines, in our lives. The job of the Christian parent is to teach this Word in your home and to proclaim it in your family's hearing. God calls parents to make his Word part of your daily speech and conversation (Deuteronomy 6:7). Martin Luther sets up his Small Catechism with each section marked, "As the head of the house should teach..."

We know that the Word of God is powerful, reliable, and applicable to everything in life. We confess that the Bible is God's own inerrant and infallible Word. We know that the Holy Spirit carried along and inspired the biblical writers. That Word describes itself as a sharp two-edged sword. Let us not run from this confession. The Lord has fit this sword, his Word, for the hands of his people, for your life and the lives of your children. The story is our story. The Word is our word. The King is our King and he lives forever. Our children and our families need this Word they need Jesus.

A life centered on the Word starts on Sunday morning. The Lord gives rest and nourishes his people by the preaching of his Word and the giving of the Sacrament during the church service. The Lord hones and sharpens his Word in our mind and heart through study and mutual conversation and consolation. Whenever you can join Sunday School and Bible Study, the Lord is at Work to feed and strengthen. On the back of our weekly prayer bulletin is a short order of service that can be used in the living room with your family or with your spouse. It's titled, "Our families pray." You can use all the parts or just some of them to fit your day or situation.

Thanks be to God that he has given us his Word and has showered us with his love. We find strength in his victory over sin and death and the devil. Jesus has won the victory for you and your children and he is with you.


