### Scripture Text: Philippians 1 & Philippians 2

In Philippians 1, Paul writes a letter to the servants of Christ Jesus. At this time he is imprisoned by the Romans. Although his current circumstances were unfavorable, he was positive and optimistic about his situation. He went on to describe how his imprisonment helped with the spread of the gospel. For this reason Paul rejoiced.
