“ 16 The eleven disciples traveled to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had directed them. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped, but some doubted. 18 Jesus came near and said to them, ‘All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.’ ”

Jesus ends the Great Commission:

Not with pressure. Not with fear. Not with guilt.

Worship & Doubt SIDE BY SIDE.

“ When they saw him, they worshiped, but some doubted.”

MATTHEW 28:17 (CSB)

God does not wait for perfect people before He calls them.

Instead, He supports imperfect people with His perfect presence.

1 - In Matthew 28:16–20, what stands out to you about the combination of worship, doubt, command, and promise? Why do you think Jesus chose to end the Great Commission with a promise of His presence?

2 - Matthew 28:17 says some of the disciples doubted. How does that challenge the idea that God only uses people who feel spiritually strong or confident? How does this encourage you personally?

3 - We see that God repeatedly calls people who feel inadequate (Moses, Gideon, Jeremiah). What does this pattern reveal about God's character and how He accomplishes His mission?

4 - The sermon emphasized that God's mission is always paired with God's presence. How might our obedience, evangelism, discipleship, or service change if we truly believed Jesus is with us in those moments?

5 - Where do you currently feel hesitant, afraid, or spiritually inadequate to obey God? How does Jesus' promise "I am with you always" speak into that specific area of your life?

6 - How should a deeper understanding of God's presence move us toward worship, gratitude, and awe? What would it look like to live this week more aware that God is truly with us?
