ARK FACTS

HOURS OF OPERATION

Instructional hours are from 8:30 am to 2:30 pm. Doors open at 8am. Late arrivals must ring the bell for access. Students can be walked by a guardian to the classroom the first week of school, but after that we ask that you drop your little one off at the front door. They will be escorted to the classroom.

ATTENDANCE AND TARDIES

Attendance will be taken daily. Students arriving after 8:30 will be considered tardy. Five tardies per quarter will be considered 1 absence. According to StepUp, students will not receive scholarship dollars if they have missed 18 days or more.

LUNCH and SNACK

We are not permitted to serve food currently. You will need to send lunch and a snack for your child. Send a water bottle with your child that has a closable lid. We can refill their bottle throughout the day if need be.

OUTDOOR PLAY

Students will play outside daily (possibly twice daily) unless the weather is a factor. Recess will never be taken from students as a form of punishment unless requested by the parents.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE

We currently do not provide after-school care, but if the need is great we may reconsider providing this for parents.

SERCURITY

Our doors will always remain locked. A minimum of 2 adults will be on the premises. Each adult will be wearing a walkie in case of emergencies. There are cameras in classrooms for the protection of the students and teachers. The footage is stored but not streamed and cannot be accessed by unauthorized persons. Teacher will have access to a panic button that can be used at any time to alert police of an emergency. Our classroom is also equipped with an extra exit door.

RELIGIOUS STUDIES

We will engage daily in prayer, scripture memorization, and students will be presented spiritual truths taught through Bible stories. We teach the trinity, salvation through the death and resurrection of Jesus alone, and God's design for marriage being 1 biological male and 1 biological female.

ACADEMIC STUDIES

The following subjects will be taught throughout the year: Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Reading, Writing, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

HOMEWORK and HOMEWORK FOLDER

We ask that you read your child 2 books at least 4 days per week. Yes, this is mommy and daddy homework, but it's vital to your child's literacy skills. We will also send home 2 pieces of homework weekly to be completed at your family's convenience. It is not our desire to weigh students down with work at home, so these will be easy, short activities. Your child will be provided with a Home/School folder that will need to go home and be returned daily.

REPORT CARD

We will send home a report card quarterly to be signed and returned.

SCHOOL CALENDAR

We know that many families have students at other schools, therefore we will do our best to mirror the Duval County Public Schools calendar.

EXCEPTION DAYS

Since Connect Church is a voting site, we will close our campus on voting days for security purposes.

CLASS DOJO

The Class DOJO application will be our primary source of communication. I will send you an invite to join my Class Dojo. It works like texting, but you can also see our class STORY. We can send each other invite private messages in real time. I will sometimes message you directly, and other times, in a group text regarding class matters. I can also award the students Dojo points for good choices and give negative Dojo points for poor choices. You will be notified when points are given.

DISCIPLINE

It is our desire to help every child maintain a positive attitude. However, sometimes children need help determining good behavior from bad behavior. Often, discipline is necessary in these instances and is part of a normal process in learning right from wrong. Here are our procedures for handling discipline:

1. Encouraging good behavior encourages good behavior. We will compliment and encourage the good things we see. This often can change behaviors immediately without directly addressing the individual student.
2. Seating switches can often change a dynamic that otherwise would be a disruption or problem of some kind.
3. A quick note to a parent on Dojo can be useful in changing behavior.
4. A phone call to a parent may be necessary to correct behavior.
5. If disruptive behavior continues, the parent may be asked to check the student out for the remainder of the day.
6. If behaviors are serious or dangerous in nature, we may suspend the student for a full day.
7. If these procedures do not curb ongoing behaviors, you may be asked to unenroll your child. All students deserve a suitable learning environment that does not cause daily anxiety and a lack of learning for the rest of the class.

We also reserve the right to discharge/unenroll a student at any time.

TOYS AT SCHOOL

We ask that no toys be brought to school unless there is a special Show and Tell day or a game day that has been previously announced.

VOLUNTEERS

We welcome volunteer help and would love to have you sign our Volunteer form. A volunteer must go through a background check to ensure the safety of your children.

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

A supply list will be generated over the summer and e-mailed to families.

PAYMENT POLICIES

Tuition is \$8,600 or \$10,600 for students requiring special support. This can be broken into 10 monthly payments of \$860 or \$1060 monthly beginning in August and ending in May. If tuition is paid through a state scholarship and it doesn't cover the full amount, the remainder can be divided and paid in equal monthly payments. Payments can be made at ArkAcademy.Education.

ENROLLMENT/RE-ENROLLMENT FEE

There is a non-refundable \$200 enrollment/re-enrollment fee that will be due at the time of enrollment. Payments can be made at ArkAcademy.Education.

REQUIRED PAPERWORK FOR NEW STUDENTS: These items can be brought to Orientation if they are not available at the time the registration packet is completed.

1. Student Health Examination document (form DH 3040) or valid exemption
2. Florida Certificate of Immunization (form DH 680) or valid exemption
3. Birth Certificate copy
4. Documentation of last known address: copy of mail with parent name and address

Orientation will be August 7th at 6pm. We will go over drop off and pick up procedures, what our day looks like, homework, communication, and other important items. Save the date! Our first day of school will be August 11th!

Scholarship Recipients

The majority of the tuition will be covered in 4 installments by the state scholarship for those students receiving scholarship dollars. If scholarship dollars do not cover the full amount, the remainder will be due by December of the enrollment year.

For students not needing special support, the tuition will be \$8,600. For students that do need special support, the tuition will be \$10,600.

Any tuition amount not covered by the scholarship will be paid by the parent by December 2025. There are no other mandatory fees.

NOT a Scholarship Recipient

For non-scholarship recipients, the yearly fee for tuition will be broken into 10 payments of \$860 or \$1060 due on the 10th of every month.

Yearly Enrollment/Re-Enrollment Fee

The enrollment/re-enrollment fee is \$200 yearly due by the first day of the enrollment school year. This is for all students.
