

Peace with God Through Faith

5 "Therefore, since we are justified by faith,¹ we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.² Through him we have also obtained access³ to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice⁴ in hope of the glory of God.⁵ Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance,⁶ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,⁷ and hope does not put us to shame because God's love⁸ has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

6 For⁹ while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.¹⁰ For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—¹¹ but God shows his love for us in that¹² while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.¹³ Since, therefore,¹⁴ we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God.¹⁵ For if¹⁶ while we were enemies¹⁷ we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.¹⁸ More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received¹⁹ reconciliation.
