### FREEDOM WEEKEND SAVE THE DATE



# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

How often do you take stock of your life? We are careful in other areas. We go for a once a year check up with our doctor. We have our cars tuned up regularly. We sit down with our financial advisor to see where we are as it relates to retirement. But how often do we step back and look at our life as a whole and ask how we are doing?

**“Imagine the difference that could be made if we were as intentional with our families as we are with other things.”**

My doctor knows what my various numbers ought to be. My mechanic knows

how my car ought to run. My financial advisor has calculators that help him see what my overall financial picture looks like. But by what standard do I measure my life as a whole? I would submit that scripture is the best measure by which to assess life.

Today we will take a look at Psalm 127, which will encourage us to take a close look at our house and home. Solomon says to us, “Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain.” So, what does it mean to allow the Lord to build our house (and home)? How do we know that we are not laboring in vain?

The answer lies in intentionality. Am I intentionally leading my family according to the scriptures? Am I intentionally discipling them? Am I intentionally investing in them? Do I spend careful, intentional time with them? Imagine the difference that could be made if we were as intentional with our families as we are with other things.


I hope that this morning will be helpful for you as we discuss these things. I trust that you will receive some practical tools that will help you to be more intentional as you think about what you are building.
