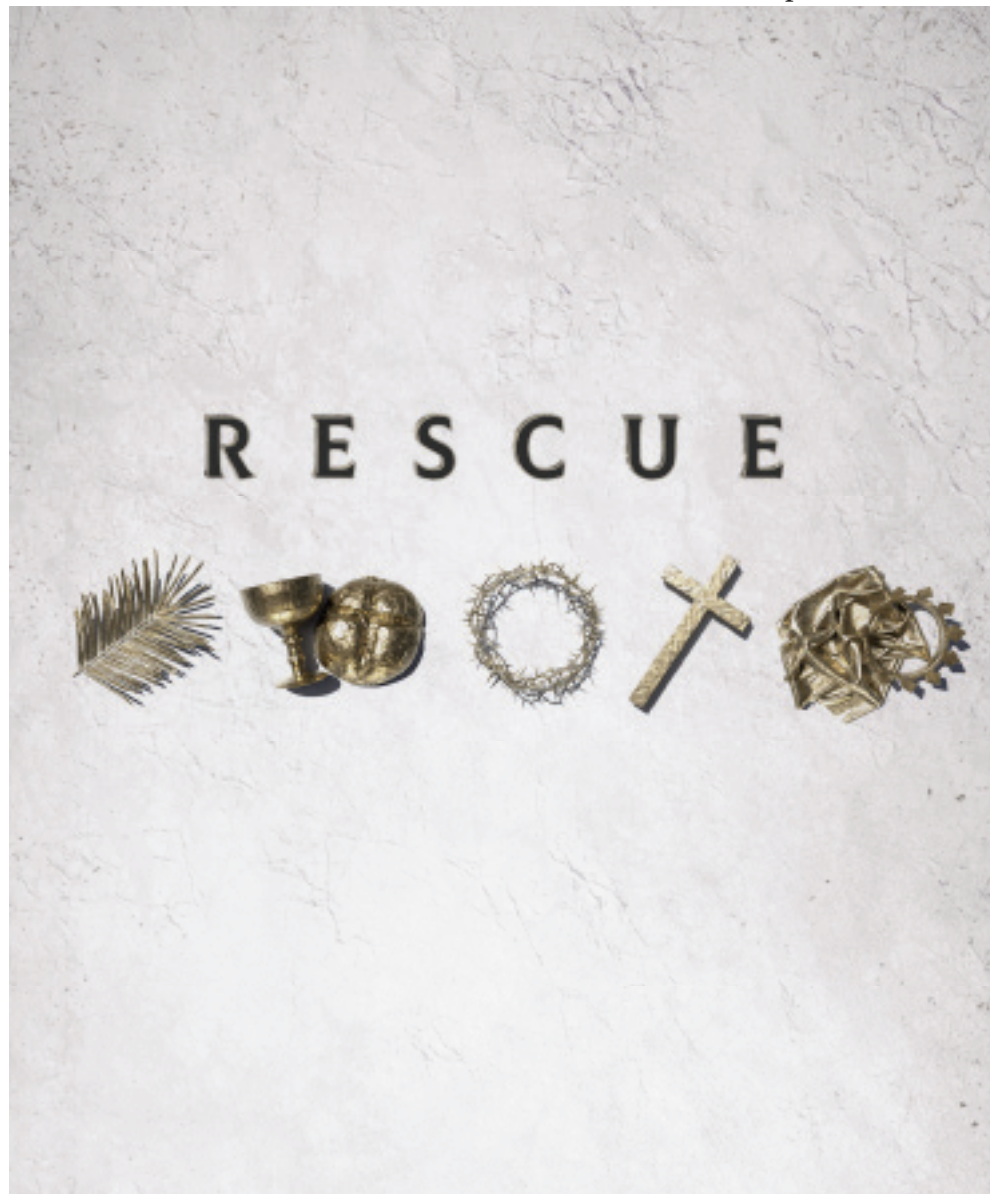
AWANA AWARDS
