This Thursday is the National Day of Prayer. I did a little research and found that this day was originally designated by the 2nd Continental Congress in 1775. It was partnered as the Spring counterpart to the fall observance of Thanksgiving, calling for a national focus of prayer and fasting in the spring, and a call of prayer and thanksgiving in the fall. They both eventually became formal laws - the observance of Thanksgiving in 1863 by President Lincoln and National Day of Prayer in 1952 under President Truman. Interestingly, both observances were ushered into law under national crises - the Civil War and the Korean War. Needless to say, prayer has always been seen, at least by some, as part of the foundation and culture of our country.

As Christians, we know that we are called to pray, and not just twice a year (although sometimes my personal prayer life can feel that infrequent). The Bible is FULL of examples of prayers, commands and directions on how to pray. Here are a couple of my favorites.

“Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.” 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

“Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.” Hebrews 4:16

This Thursday is our monthly First Thursday Prayer & Praise service. If you have not yet attended, you should make it a priority this week. We will be led by our American Heritage Girls and Trail Life students. It will be a great time of guided prayer time as well as some dynamic worship, led out by some of the students. We rehearsed last night, and I assure you it will be a very blessed time. Please consider coming and joining us - we know that prayer works. God has called His people to pray - in adoration of who He is, for our own lives and influence in the world, and for the world itself. He even asks us to pray for our enemies! I want us to be a praying church. I want our community to know that when they are in need, the people of Northside will stand in the gap for them. I leave you with another of my favorite prayers - Aaron’s priestly prayer from Numbers:

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.






TRIAD GROUP MEETING


PRAYER AND PRAISE-NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER


