<sup>6</sup>For 'while we were still weak, at the right time 'Christ died for the ungodly.' For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—<sup>7</sup>but God shows his love for us in that <sup>8</sup>'while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.' <sup>9</sup>Since, therefore, 'we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from <sup>10</sup>the wrath of God.' <sup>11</sup>For if <sup>12</sup>'while we were enemies' we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. <sup>13</sup>More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received <sup>14</sup>reconciliation.
