THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY


Humans were created for community. In fact, from the beginning God said, “It is not good that man should be alone...” (Genesis 2:18). Unfortunately, it is harder and harder to find genuine community. People are busier than ever before. We are overcommitted and stretched thin. As a result, we pull back from the very things that would make a real difference for us.

Within the context of the church, we have groups that are structured for community. Some of these groups meet on Sunday mornings at 9:30. Some of these groups meet on Sunday nights at 5:00. Some of these groups meet on campus and some off. These are smaller groups, often less than 20 people, and allow for greater intimacy.

Within these groups, we are able to be committed to the very things we will see in our text today. We can be committed to deep, meaningful Bible study. We can experience genuine fellowship. We can worship together as we rejoice over the things that the Lord has done. And we can pray together and for one another.

I have hosted the same Journey Group for almost two years. It has been exciting to see how God has moved. We have watched as group members have prayed for each other and cared for each other. We have watched as relationships have developed and bonds have been formed. We have studied together and prayed together. It is a lot of work to host such a group, but I can tell you, the rewards are unmatched.

So, today, as we look at the ministry of groups, there are several questions that need to be answered. Am I part of a group? Am I willing to lead a group? Is there a void in my life that being part of a group might fill? What is God’s call as it relates to my life and groups? Only you can answer these questions, but I pray you will listen closely to the voice of God as you do.
