SUMMIT CAMP REGISTRATION



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Within Israel, there are two bodies of water that stand in stark contrast to one another. The first is the Sea of Galilee and the second is the Dead Sea. They are connected by the Jordan River. Here is the interesting thing, the Sea of Galilee is teeming with life and the Dead Sea is void of life. What is the difference? The Sea of Galilee has outflow. The Dead Sea does not have outflow.

“However, when it is time to sacrifice and serve, they say, “Not me!” Over time they become a toxic blend of theological truth and bible knowledge.”

Water comes down through the Jordan River, into the Dead Sea, but the only means of escape from there is

evaporation. If you remember your eighth-grade science, you know that salt and minerals cannot evaporate. What happens over time is that you end up with a toxic cocktail of salt and minerals in the Dead Sea; nothing can live there.

I do not want to assume too much, but sometimes I wonder if God did not put these two bodies of water where they are to remind us of the simple fact that outflow equals life. Too many Christians are like the Dead Sea. There is plenty of inflow. They go to Bible Study, they attend worship, and they connect in groups. However, when it is time to sacrifice and serve, they say, “Not me!” Over time they become a toxic blend of stagnant theological truth and bible knowledge.


However, we can easily move from being Dead Sea Christians to Sea of Galilee Christians. We can involve ourselves in the service of the Lord providing the much needed outflow. There are many forms that our service can take. Maybe it is within the church. Maybe it is outside the church. Maybe it is near. Maybe it is far. Regardless, we need to be serving. It is a natural part of the maturation process for the Christian life.
