THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Today, we will continue our discussion of the Sabbath. As we have continued to navigate the fourth commandment, “Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy” (Ex 20:8), we continue to seek understanding. As we look today at Genesis 2:1-3, we will discover three things about the first Sabbath Day. First, God finished His work. Second, God rested. And third, God blessed the day and made it holy.

It is in these three realities that I believe we begin to discover how we ought to approach the Sabbath. We have already seen that the Sabbath is for rest, recovery, and reflection. It is a day for us to step back and allow for healing to take place within our bodies. The nature of this healing is physical, spiritual, and emotional. With today’s text, we will discover the importance of recognizing God’s greatness, enjoying His creation, and worshiping Him.

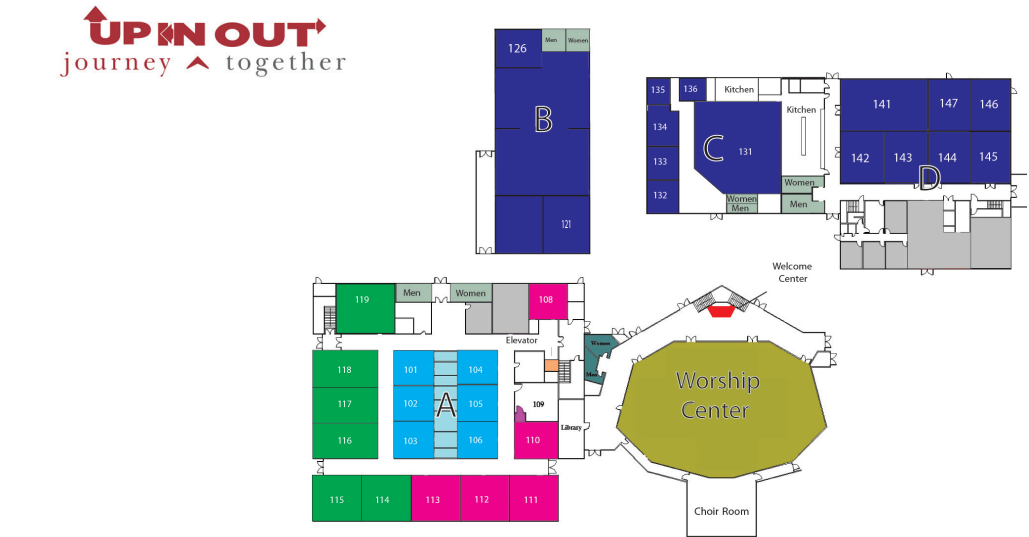
It is easy to become too legalistic and narrow in our thinking as it relates to the Sabbath. However, we must remember Jesus’ words in Mark 2:27, “The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.” The Sabbath is a gift to us. Clearly, God has given us instruction as to how to make the most of the Sabbath, but He does not intend for us to live our lives in such a way that we are worried that every move is somehow a violation of the Sabbath. His instructions were simple, “remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy.” He did tell us to cease from our work, but beyond that, He did not give a lot of rules.

Here is my real hope and prayer: I pray that you will get into the habit of taking one day out of seven and pulling back. That you would cease from your labor. Cease from those things that require a ton of physical, mental, and emotional strength. I would hope that you would take time to enjoy the creation of our God, talk to Him, and allow Him to bring restoration to your mind, body, and soul. I pray that we will realize that the Sabbath is a gift offered to us that should not be neglected.
