
⁵ ^aTherefore, since we have been justified by faith,^b we^c have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.^d Through him we have also^e received access^f to this grace in which we stand, and we^g rejoice^h in hope of the glory of God. ⁱ Not only that, but we^j rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering^k produces endurance,^l and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,^m andⁿ hope does not put us to shame because God's love^o has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶ For^p while we were still weak, at the right time^q Christ died for the ungodly.^r For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—^s but^t God shows his love for us in that^u while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.^v Since, therefore,^w we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from^x the wrath of God.^y For if^z while we were enemies^{aa} we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by^{ab} his life.^{ac} More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received^{ad} reconciliation.
