THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Once a follower of Christ realizes that much of the Old Testament foreshadows the New Testament, a world of wonder opens to them. Over the last few weeks, we have taken a look at the Sabbath. In our examination, we have sought to understand God's call to a day of rest and reflection. We have determined that this is God's gift to us, that we might work within His established rhythm of 6/1.

However, like much of what we see in the Old

Testament, the Sabbath stands as a foreshadowing of something much greater. The reality is, Jesus Christ is our ultimate Sabbath rest. Taking a day off can renew our minds, our hearts, and even our souls. However, nothing can give us new life outside of Jesus Christ. All of our wrestling and struggling can only be relieved by recognizing that ultimate rest comes in Christ and Christ alone.

When you think about the way life is – the stress, the anxiety, the uncertainty, and the like – you realize that you need something much bigger than yourself to overcome it all. All our efforts are in vain. All our working is futility. All our solutions fail. Then, we are left struggling to come up with yet another solution. Then, even if we do, that fails too.

Jesus says in Matthew 11:28-30, “Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” Does this not sound like the stark opposite of the way we live our lives? We push and pull to no effect. We struggle, but never overcome. And yet, Jesus says, come to me. His yoke is easy. His burden in light. It is in Him that we can find rest.


I hope that if you are struggling today, you will turn to Jesus. Stop trying to overcome on your own and turn to the one who has already won the victory.
