
#### All things will work out according to His will.

Upward Flag Football registration begins July 20. The tentative schedule is: Practices begin the week of August 31. The first game is September 19. The last game is October 31.


We will also need coaches and referees. Go to the event page on nbcvictoria.org to register or volunteer.


