

### SPECIAL CALLED CHURCH CONFERENCE


We will have a special called church conference on Wednesday, August 7, to approve our next round of committees. We will meet in Bldg D at 7pm.

# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

It is easy to look at the condition of our nations, and even our world, and simply wonder – how long oh Lord? How long must we wait? How long before you come and get us? How long before we can enjoy all of the pleasures of heaven and be set free from this world? All of these are understandable questions, but are they the ones that God would have us to ask?

As we take a look at the Old Testament book of Jeremiah this morning, we are going to see a group of people who had been removed from their homes. God had caused the Israelites to be exiled to Babylon. Because they would not honor Him or follow Him, they fell under His judgement. As they were transported to Babylon, there were prophets that were telling them this would only last a year or two and it would soon be over. However, God said not so.

God had several words of instruction for these Israelites as they found themselves in Babylon. First of all, God told them to get busy living; they will be there a while. He told them to build homes, get married, have children. They were not going to be leaving Babylon anytime soon. This serves as good advice for us as well. We know that one day Christ will return, but we do not know when. Until then, we need to get busy living in a God honoring way that we might impact the world in which we have been placed.

Next, the people are told they must seek the welfare of the city in which they find themselves. Instead of hating their new home and just looking to leave, they are to seek ways to make a real difference. Not only are they to seek the welfare of the city, but they are to seek the Lord as well. They are then reminded, as the city prospers, they will prosper. If the city fails, they will fail too. This serves as a great reminder for us to seek the welfare of the city in which we find ourselves. Do not become a disgruntled resident that wants only to leave.


