It seems like overnight we went from summer, fun, and sun to suddenly, everything has taken off again. This is true in my family life, and it is true in church life. All of our ministries are kicking off – from kids to youth to adults. We are also beginning a new semester of bible studies for all ages. While these seasons can be stressful, they are also exciting.

As if all of this is not enough, we are also beginning the process of searching for two new staff ministers. The key word in the previous sentence is “process.”

We view the calling of ministers as a sacred task. We would make a mistake to rush. It will take a little time to assess the exact needs of the church as well as the sort of person God is calling.

Here is how the process generally works: Our Personnel Committee meets and prays. They begin to assess the needs of the church and the sort of minister that will be a good fit. As part of this process, they will look at job descriptions and see if they need to be refined or changed. Once we have a general sense of what we are looking for, job ads will be posted in the appropriate places, and we will begin reviewing resumes.


Out of the resumes that are received, a few will be selected for further follow-up. Sometimes this takes the form of a questionnaire and sometimes it might be a remote interview. Generally speaking, out of these interviews, a single candidate will be selected that we will proceed with. However, it might be that none of these candidates seem like a good fit and the process backs up a bit.

Once a candidate is selected, and they sense God’s leading to come to Northside, that candidate will be presented to the church for a vote. This process will be the same for both the Children’s Pastor and the Discipleship Pastor.

I have been asked several times how long the process will take. The truth is, we have no clue. When I was called as pastor, they were anticipating a two-year search, and it took eight months. Other positions we have sought pastors for have taken well over a year. The only thing I can promise is that we will move as expeditiously as possible.

Be prayerful and patient. I would caution against rumors and grumbling. These things only sow seeds of dissension and are rarely rooted in truth. If you have questions, please ask me or one of our personnel committee members. We will tell you as much as we can. Also know that some things are a matter of confidentiality and cannot be shared.

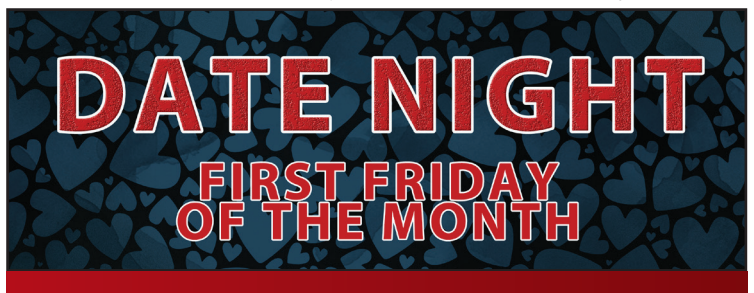
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

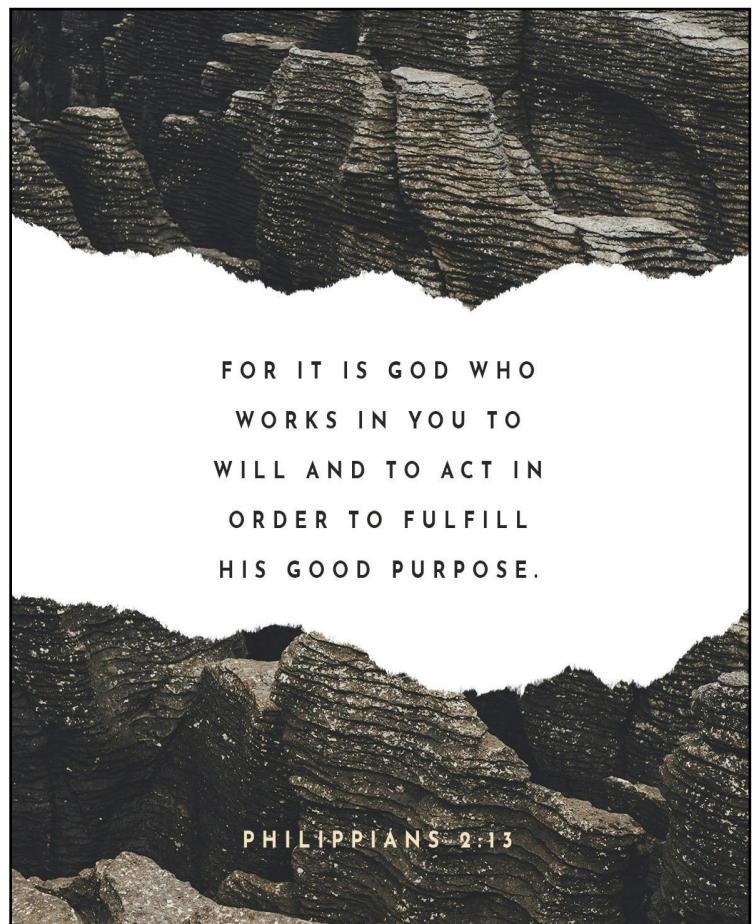
