THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Salvation is a precious gift that should never be taken for granted. Ephesians 2:8-9 tells us, "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." We know that our salvation is an act of God, whereby He calls the one who was dead in their trespasses and sins (Eph 2:1) and makes us alive together with Christ (Eph 2:4). There is nothing you or I did to deserve this. There is nothing that you or I did to earn this. It is a completely and totally a gift from God.

However, we must ask ourselves a very serious question: "What am I to do with this gift God has given me?" We find the answer in today's text. Paul tells us, "Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (Phil 2:12). If we just take a quick glance at this verse, we might wonder how it is that we are saved by grace and commanded to work out our own salvation with fear and trembling.

I use a program that assists me in my biblical studies. The name of this program is Logos. Within this program, I literally have thousands of resources at my disposal. However, it is not only the resources that make this program amazing, but the numerous study tools and mechanisms. The reality is, Logos will do whatever you know how to make it do. Here is the sad thing: whenever I use this program, I am the equivalent of an old man driving a new corvette through town at the speed limit. I promise you I am only using about 10% of what this program will do.

In many ways, our salvation is like this. God intends for our salvation to work itself out in every area of our life. He has given it to us at no expense or effort of our own. However, He expects us to be part of the process of salvation taking root in every facet of who we are. We do this by reading the word, by being obedient, and by trusting the Spirit's leadership.


The only question that remains is, are you working out? No, not that sort of working out. Are you working out your salvation in every area of your life?
